BEHAVIORAL LEVELS FOR IN CLASS/CAMPUS INCIDENTS

All Incidents must be documented in PowerSchool.

Tier I Incidents - Teacher's Responsibility

Gum chewing/Eating in Class Poor work habits/Grades Disruption Inattentiveness Misuse of electronic devices Cheating

Uniform violation Minor annoyances Inappropriate language

Tardiness/Attendance Lack of materials PDA

Tier II Incidents - Referral to Administrator (All Tier I Interventions Have Been Exhausted)

Attendance/Truancy Excessive tardies Repetitive misuse of electronics
Harassment (Minor) Uncooperative student 5+ Documented Uniform Violations

Consistent lack of materials Bullying/Hazing (Minor) Poor academic grades

Consistent failure to complete assignments Repetitive PDA

Tier III Incidents - Administrator's Responsibility

Threatened/caused/attempted physical injury

Disruption of school activities

Received stolen school or private property

Bullying/Cyber bullying

Drug paraphernalia

Possessed or used tobacco

Damaged/attempt to damage school or private property Hazing

Damageu/attempt to damage school of private property maxing

Stole or attempted to steal school or private property Robbery/Extortion

Possession of controlled substance Sexual harassment

Harassed/threatened/intimidated pupil/school personnel Hate violence Harassed/threatened intimidated witness Imitation firearm Possession of or Selling Controlled substance Terroristic threat

Marijuana possession for 1st offense of less than 1oz

Infliction of physical injury

Willful use of force /violence not self defense.

TIERED INTERVENTIONS

PROGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR CHECKPOINTS - CONDOR - HERITAGE

Please follow the progressive order outlined below in addressing student behavior:

TIER I INTERVENTIONS (List Not Exhaustive - Please refer to Tiered Intervention Menu)

- Warning
- Alternatives
 - Move from seat
 - Pre-arranged teacher buddy
 - Other teacher generated options
- Call parent
- Parent conference
- Daily behavior report
- Teacher Mentoring during recess/lunch (**Teacher initiated mentoring is the teachers responsibility**)
- Student Success Team meeting (SST)
- Removal from class (Evidence of progressive discipline must be completed. Referral form must be completed and teachers must provide student work - Teacher keeps Chromebook)

TIER II INTERVENTIONS (List Not Exhaustive - Please refer to Tiered Intervention Menu)

- Counsel student
- Parent conference
- Daily behavior report
- Harm Circle
- Student Accountability Board
- SART (Student Attendance Review Team)
- Student Success Team meeting
- Refer to School Psychologist
- Refer to outside counseling/services
