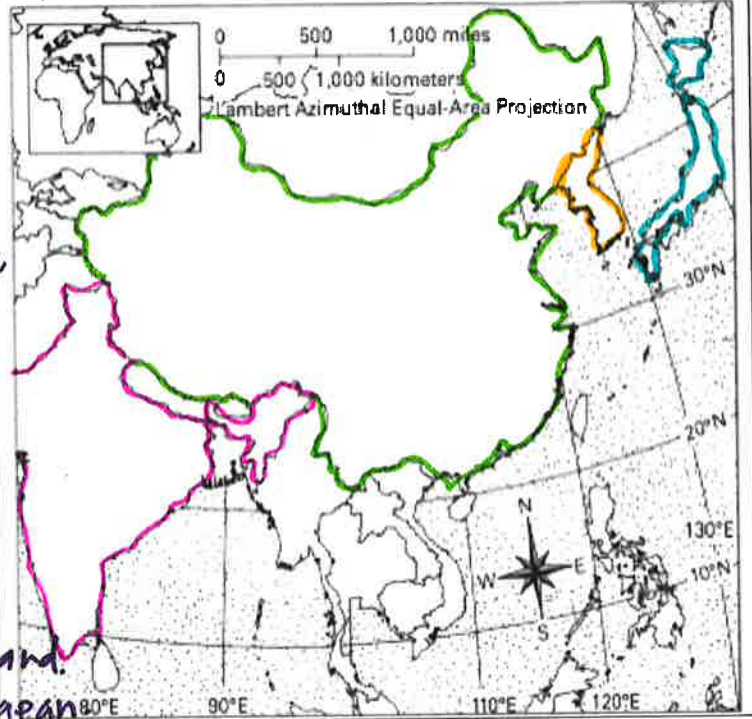
19.1: Cultural Influences on Japan

Ruler of Japan around 593. He admired Chinese and Korean culture and encouraged contact to the mainland.
- How was Japan's government organized?

Power was divided among clan chiefs called uji - some grew to control large areas

 - Through gifts sent from the mainland.
 - Korean workers who migrated to Japan.

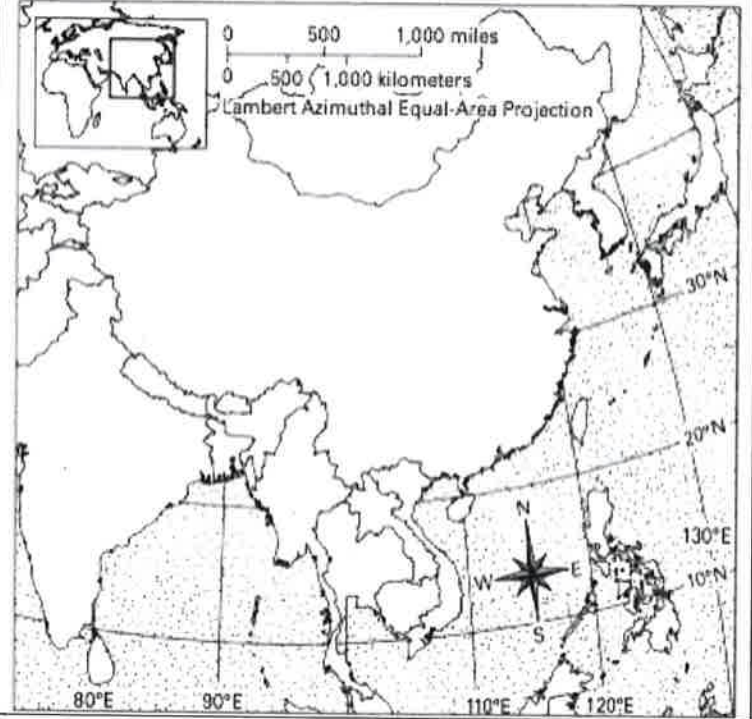
