_____Step 2: Label and analyze 3 different "parts" of your image: (15 points; 5 points each).

- Label a piece of your image that represents either the Renaissance or the Reformation
- Write 3-4 sentences describing the significance of the piece (how does that piece of the picture represent the Renaissance or Reformation culture?) Use the back of this paper as scratch or rough draft space.
- See me to connect your image with your paragraph with string.
- Repeat with 2 more parts of the image.

_Step 3: Significance of Image (10 points)

In 4–5 sentences write the significance of your image to main historical ideas of the Reformation or Renaissance. Use your notes! Answer the following questions to help you:

- What is this a picture of? Describe it.
- Is it a primary source from the Reformation or the Renaissance? How do you know it's a primary source?
- What does this picture tell you about the Renaissance or Reformation? (use your notes. 3 sentences).
- See me to connect all your labels to your final paragraph.

Extra credit: Make it into a "stalker board" by making connections to the other image options or any of the images we've looked at this quarter (like the ones from your notes. I'll have extras printed for you). Extra connections=extra credit!
